PICK A PROGRAMME

The **Higher Certificate** programme is a one year NQF 5 qualification. The **Diploma** is a three year NQF 6 qualification. The **Advanced Diploma** is a one year NQF 7 qualification with the Diploma as pre-requisite.

REGISTER

Registration for Semester 1 closes 15 February each year. Registration for Semester 2 (yes, you can register for the first time in the middle of the year!) closes 15 August. Semesters run March to June and August to November.

ONLINE DISTANCE LEARNING

The programmes are presented via **online distance learning**. Contact sessions are recorded for you to view at your convenience. You can study Aviation Management and complete your flight training simultaneously!

PASS YOUR EXAMS

Exams are written at 43 Air School or any Stadio exam venue (there are many across South Africa). Should you complete your flight training at 43 and move abroad, arrangements can be made to write outstanding exams wherever you are.
